R. Walker Garrett is a lifelong resident of Columbus, Georgia, and a graduate of St. Anne-Pacelli Catholic School. He graduated magna cum laude from Huntingdon College in Montgomery, Alabama, in May 2007 with a degree in Political Science and minors in Business Administration and History. While at Huntingdon, he played varsity tennis, starting at both singles and doubles. Mr. Garrett earned his Juris Doctor from Mercer University School of Law in May 2010, along with a Certificate in Advanced Legal Writing, Research, and Drafting. While at Mercer, he received the CALI Award for the highest grade in Advanced Legal Research and served as a research assistant to Tax Professor Monica Armstrong.

Upon graduating from law school, Mr. Garrett joined a boutique litigation firm specializing in catastrophic injury litigation and Federal Employers Liability Act (FELA) cases, representing injured railroad union workers. Mr. Garrett is licensed to practice in the State and Superior Courts of Georgia, the Supreme Court of Georgia, the U.S. District Courts for the Northern and Middle Districts of Georgia, the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Alabama, Alabama state courts, and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. He also represented hundreds of businesses and individuals in claims arising from the BP Deepwater Horizon oil spill, recovering millions of dollars for clients throughout the Gulf Coast. Mr. Garrett joined Morgan & Morgan in August 2018, where he continues to represent individuals harmed by the negligence and wrongful actions of others.

Mr. Garrett is a member of the Georgia Trial Lawyers Association and has chaired educational seminars for fellow attorneys. He also served on the Board of the General Practice and Trial Section of the State Bar of Georgia, where he was editor and a contributor to *Calendar Call* magazine, a statewide legal publication. As part of the Section's commitment to community service, he was the first city captain for the "Ask-a-Lawyer" pro bono service day in Columbus and continues to lead the event each year.

In the community, Mr. Garrett served two terms as Board Chairman of The Literacy Alliance, a nonprofit dedicated to ending illiteracy in the Chattahoochee Valley. He continues to support the organization by taking adult literacy students to the Georgia State Capitol to meet their legislators during Literacy Day.
