Stephen Bott grew up in Grand Forks, North Dakota. He attended Vanderbilt University in Nashville, TN, where he earned a Bachelor of Music Degree, cum laude. At Vanderbilt, he received a Blair Honor Scholarship for all four years and twice won the Heard Prize for Excellence.

Stephen received his Juris Doctor, with Distinction, from the University of North Dakota School of Law. During law school, Stephen had an article published in the North Dakota Law Review, where he served as the Student Articles Editor. He also worked for the Central Legal Research Program that assisted prosecutors, court-appointed defense attorneys, pro-se litigants, and judges, with legal research issues.

Prior to joining Morgan & Morgan, Stephen worked as the Staff Attorney for the Northeast Central Judicial District of North Dakota. In that role, Stephen supported five State Court Judges, and two referees by providing legal research, and the writing of legal opinions, orders, and other documents for both civil and criminal cases.
