While clerking, Mr. Losey analyzed a wide variety of civil and criminal motions and appeals. Clerking taught him how to read the law carefully and closely. He prides himself on meticulously reading the law and understanding what arguments it supports, and what arguments it does not support.

Mr. Losey has been a member of the Maryland Bar since 2021 and the California bar since 2023. He is also admitted to practice in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California.
